## **Student Expectations**

Confirmation is a big step in a young person's faith and commitment to the church community. Through a series of classes, service opportunities, and mentoring your student will learn the basic foundations of the Episcopal church's beliefs and theology, but it is also much more than that. Confirmation allows young people to experience faith in community, dig into hard questions, practice service, and build foundations for an authentic, real relationship with God. This group of students and their mentors grow as a community within itself and will continue encouraging and challenging one another long after confirmation ends.

### What are the expectations for students?

- Regular worship attendance at the 9 am service
- Attending Confirmation Class 10:15 -11:45 am
- Time spent with their mentor
- Attending the opening retreat
- Engagement with their service project
- Participation in EYC activities (Sunday Night Youth & Special Events)

Community is an important part of confirmation so being involved in the life of the church community is necessary because we have to be together to grow together. We also know that life is busy! Students can miss one class and they will be asked to schedule a make-up session the following week.

Each student will complete a service project of thier choosing. The will receive a \$100 seed fund from the church to launch their efforts. Students will work in conjunction with their mentor on these projects, during some meeting times, but will require work outside of Sunday gatherings.
